RULING

<u>I. MAIGE, J</u>

This is an application for extension of time to apply for reference against the decision of Hon. Tengwa, Taxing Master dated 21st January 2020. The application is made under section 14(1) of the Law of Limitation Act. It is founded on the affidavit of Isaack Zake, learned advocate for the applicant. The respondent, aside from rebutting the facts in the affidavit by way of a

counter affidavit, he has questioned the maintainability of the application for being wrongly preferred.

In his brief submissions in support of the preliminary objection, Mr. Rafael David, learned advocate for the respondent submits that the provision of section 14 of the Law of Limitation Act is not the appropriate provision of law to move the court for extension of time to file a reference against the decision of a Taxing Master. In his understanding, which I full subscribe to, the relevant provision is order 8 (1) of the Advocates Remunerations Order, 2015 which provides that; " the High Court may, subject to order 7 extend time for filing a reference upon sufficient cause". He prays therefore that the application be struck out for being incompetent.

Mr. Zake for the applicants conceded with the preliminary objection but prayed that he be allowed to file a fresh application.

I agree with both counsel that, the instant application in so far as it is preferred under section 14 of the Law of Limitation Act instead of order

8(1) of the Advocates Remunerations Order, 2015 is incompetently before the Court. It is accordingly struck out with costs.
